**ITEM NO. 48.5 TO APPROVE AND RATIFY THE PROPOSED INNOVATION AND BEST PRACTICES ADOPTED BY THE COLLEGE (FOR INFORMATION)**

- Rain water collection and storage system has been created and the rain water collected is used for wash room and gardening purposes
- Maintenance of Roof Top Solar operated power generation (200 kW capacity) system.
- For making the campus green, a scheme involving students has been initiated. Under this scheme each student will plant 5 trees and take care of them during their study period of 3 to 4 years.

**ITEM NO. 48.6:- TO REVIEW THE TRAINING AND PLACEMENT FOR THE YEARS 2019-2020, 2020-2021 & 2021 -22**

Joining hands with all the departments, the Placement Cell has offered more than 1100 man-hours of training to the students to equip them for the recruitment process. Students were allowed to use BYOD lab with Wifi facility. This enabled the students to take up a total of around 130 topic-wise, full-length and company-specific online assessments through Skillrack and E Box along with additional online practices not only enhanced the students' learning abilities but also boosted their confidence level. Based on the scores obtained, class-wise ranking was done and top scorers were recognised and appreciated. The results were displayed in the respective classrooms which helped them to understand where they stood.

Also the slow learners were identified and additional coaching was given to them.

Reference books for Aptitude were given to all the final year students for extensive practice. Exclusive Soft Skills sessions were conducted with focus on topics such as Public Speaking, Body Language, Personal Grooming, Interview Skills, Mock GD Sessions etc that eventually helped students to go through the recruitment process confidently.

The Placement Cell has exclusive training team and train students by using online platforms like Skillrac and E Box for Programming and assessment, for industry certification Infosys Spring board and L & T Edutech, for skill enhancement Top Fresher's and many companies. Our College is also empanelled with L & T, CTS, Mphasis, Bosch and many companies.

The Management has taken tremendous efforts and initiatives to provide maximum number of opportunities for the students to get placed in top Multi-National Companies. This year on the whole we have offered about 105 exclusive opportunities in various Corporates out of which 900 students have been placed.

As on date 90% of our 2022 batch students are placed in companies with higher packages, 5.2 Lacs per annum being the highest offered by. 31 students have been offered salary between Rs. 4 to Rs.5 LPA per annum by other product Companies which are Vuram, Appranix, Full Creative, Hexaware, Mallow Technologies, Tata Elexi, Soft square, Pinnacle Infotech

204 students are placed in companies – TCS, CTS, Infosys, Mphasis, Wipro, Capgemini, EPISource, Xcel Corp, Vinsinfo, MSC Technology, CIEL, Acies Global,6Accenture, VHR Solutions, Quest Global, Face Prep and Kotak with package of 3 Lacs and above per annum.


